Dear Dr. Nichols:

This will acknowledge your letter of
June 2.

As I am sure you understand, I have no
authority to release private papers of the Kennedy
family to anyone. If I did so, I would have no
basis on which to distinguish among particular
papers, of which there are many thousands, or
between individuals asking to see them.

I would like to add that I cannot see that
this makes any difference in the case of your
request. Insofar as the transfer of the autopsy
photographs and X-rays is concerned, the memo-
randum simply contains a list of the items,
which also appears as Appendix B to a letter
agreement of October 29, 1966 by which I gave
the autopsy photographs and X-rays to the United
States on behalf of the Kennedy family. For your
information I am enclosing a copy of Appendix B
to that agreement.
