I would like to remind you that I have not yet received a substantive response to my letter to you dated March 22, 1977 concerning my FOIA request. In a letter to me dated March 25, 1977, you indicated that you would withhold action on my letter pending my administrative appeal of fees charged to me for search time. That appeal is now complete and I have decided not to pursue the search fee matter further. I have remitted the appropriate amount to the Secret Service.

Since writing my letter of March 22, other related matters have come to my attention. One is the subject of a separate letter which I enclose. I have chosen to write separately for my own filing purposes.

I have learned that the Secret Service has released documents possibly relevant to my request but which have not yet been provided to me. I would like copies of the following:

- 1. In Secret Service file CO-2-34030 there is a memo dated 11/17/66 from James J. Rowley to David C. Acheson entitled "Photographs and X-rays of Autopsy of President Kennedy." This memo refers to "your November 4th memorandum to the Secretary." It also mentions an "attached letter." I would like copies of both documents referred to in this memo.
- 2. A memo dated 12/2/66 from Roy Kellerman to Mr. Rowley concerns delivery of C.E. 350, the windshield, to the National Archives. This memo refers to a letter dated 11/28/66 from Martin Richman and an attached receipt. I would like a copy of both.

I appreciate your time and attention and look forward to a speedy reply to my letter of March 22. Please note that I have changed my address.
