On CE 391, I am pretty sure that "1221" is the SS control number. On the 185-page list, that SS number on CD 498 is marked "Mr. Specter has" by hand. This also appears on the cover letter, dated 3/13 - just in time for the doctors' testimony on 3/16. Jim asked for this control number for other reasons and was told that it "is not among the Commission's records." I expect that has to do with misfiling, and is not uncommon for CD's made into CE's, but you may wish to pursue it.
