Re memo to SAC dated 12/27/67 concerning the spent cartridge found by WILLIAM A. BARBEE at 1615 Stemmons Freeway in Dallas in July or August, 1966.

IC STEVE ALBRIGHT and SA WALLACE R. HEITMAN surveyed the above area on 12/29/67 and the following information was noted:

1615 Stemmons is at a location approximately one mile north, as the crow flies, from the Texas School Book Depository. It is noted OSWALD fired from the south side window of the Texas School Book Depository. From the ground at 1615 Stemmons, the School Book Depository cannot be seen, nor can the building at 1615 Stemmons be seen from the ground at the School Book Depository.

Photographs were taken looking toward the School Book Depository from 1615 Stemmons and also looking toward 1615 Stemmons from the School Book Depository.
