Facts of complaint

C advised that he is employed at Louisiana National Guard, 39th Aviation Bn., Bldg. 101, New Orleans Lakefront Airport, New Orleans.

C advised that after seeing Subject OSWALD'S photograph on TV in connection with recent Assassination of President Kennedy, he is fairly certain that he saw OSWALD come out of the office of Subject KRIMMERMAN, who was a professor of Symbolic Logic at LSUNO last Spring Semester when C was a student there. C advised he saw OSWALD about May or June of the Spring Semester.

C further advised that Subject KRIMMERMAN would frequently invite him to meetings at Tulane University described by C as seminars. C refused to attend these meetings because he had suspected KRIMMERMAN of being Anti-American since KRIMMERMAN always managed to bring the Marxist theory into his lectures.

C advised that Subject MURPHY was a student with him and in KRIMMERMAN'S classes. C further advised that MURPHY would frequently become involved in debates with KRIMMERMAN.

C advised that he does not know whether KRIMMERMAN is still employed at LSUNO but understood that MURPHY was to take a graduate course at Tulane University this year.

C also advised that KRIMMERMAN also distributed literature which C considered detrimental to the United States and which C would immediately destroy.
