In denying The Washington Post story, the Justice Depart-ment said, "While the federal investigation has narrowed the list of possible suspects, it has not gone beyond that.

"The two-month investigation has already produced more than 1,000 pages of reports and is continuing. An exhaustive review of these reports is now underway, but a determination of appropriate federal action cannot be made until this process is com-pleted."
