

## Deputy Unidentified, Justice Dept. Claims

The Justice Department yesterday denied a published report, that the FBI has tentatively identified a deputy sheriff who killed two students at Southern University last Nov. 16.

In an article published yes-

terday, The Washington Post quoted Justice Department sources as saying the deputy had been identified tentatively and was expected to become the subject of a federal grand jury investigation in Louisiana.

The Washington Post also said the FBI had reported that a single shotgun blast fired by the deputy killed the two students at the Baton Rouge school.

In denying The Washington Post story, the Justice Department said, "While the federal investigation has narrowed the list of possible suspects, it has not gone beyond that.

"The two-month investigation has already produced more than 1,000 pages of reports and is continuing. An exhaustive review of these reports is now underway, but a determination of appropriate federal action cannot be made until this process is completed."
