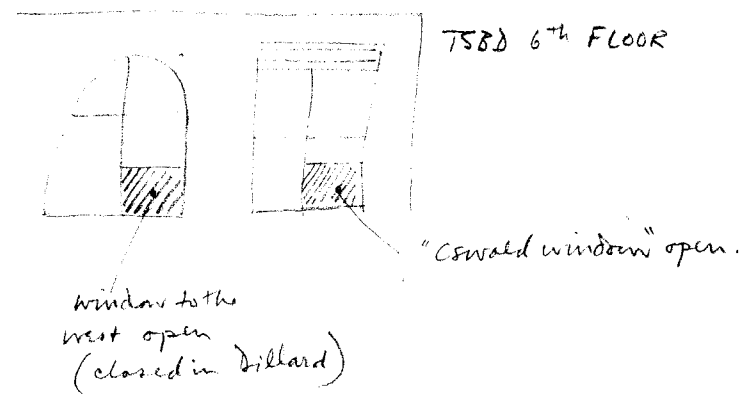

Mr. Weisberg:

Things are beginning to move. I am going to see Gary Murr Thursday (6 June) and we may get to see Similas soon after that. Similas told Gary that he has four pictures that he will show us.

Most interesting is this: Similas told Gary that he took the Liberty magazine picture about 10 minutes after the assassination. The window to the west of "Oswald's window" is half open, although it is closed in Dillard's photos. Here is diagram of position of windows in Similas Liberty picture:



Supposedly, the uncropped version of Similas' picture shows the clock on top of TSBD. I have found more evidence, however, that bears on the position of the windows and the timing of the pictures. Read on.
