Dear Boss,

As you know, I am silent when I am busy and have nothing to ask or say. Your 10/2 clipping was helpful. If and when the complete book about the poll is printed, you will see how important to it the clipping on the Harris poll (not published here) is.

I now have a favor to ask of one of you. Someone who is working with me is interested in the arrest of some Cuban mercenaries reported in the Miami Herald 6/20/63. He would like to have the picture they then published. They brushed him off, telling him copies of that issue are exhausted, which is meaningless.

The library should have either bound or microfilm copies of that issue. If you or Karen has time, it would be a good idea to examine a few subsequent issues to get any court decision that may have been published. The accompanying story might explain the picture.

Once you have identified the specific picture, it is usually possible to buy it from the paper (here the charge is \$3.00). If they are interested, it is not for publication. If the paper gave the names, left to rights in the trade, he should also have them.

Some of these people figure in some of the stories of the JFK assassination. Others are in the recent Haiti paper.

One version of the cause of the arrest may interest you. One of their members was shot dead. The other explained they mistook him for a wild turkey. On another occasion, their skin-diving expert died in ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ bathtub-deep water. Verdict: accidental drowning.

I think the arrests were at Ho-Nume Cay.

Not as important, but if you have time, it would interest me if you could scan the papers for October and get for me, if it was reported, the arrest of Loren Eugene "Skin" Hall that year with a trailer-load of rifles, etc. He was let go, his weapons confiscated.
