Harold:

I just discovered that on campus we have photographic facilities that will allow me to get good pictures merely for

the cost of film and developing.

With this machine I can get 35mm color slides of any pictures or other 35mm slides. I have not used the equipment yet, but I was told that it is easy to operate and produces excellent quality reproductions. With the negatives, I can have stuff rendered as prints or as slides.

I mention this in case you want to use the facility for ine inexpensive copying of photos. It's a boon for me, since I can now borrow pictures and make good copies for my own collection. Also I had wanted to render my prints into slides for illustrations in lectures; presently I use an opaque projector which is cumbersome and, with its heat, somewhat damaging to my pictures.

If there is any way in which you wish to use this facility,

please let me know. Also, if you have photographic material that you think would interest me, please let me borrow it until I can

make copies for myself.
