Dear Howard (cc. Harold):

Thanks for your letter of 8 March and the enclosures. Do not be bothered if my recent letters make me appear uncooperative. I am, but it is a thing that will pass. I could, in a sense, attribute it to particular causes, but since I have been through similar moods before, when I might have attributed them to other causes, that way, I know that it is just a kind of fit, and I know that it will go. If I look for reasons, I am still there, and they complicate the matter is not that it need not be complicated, for they are really not important. I am feeling, but I tell you truly that it is not a cause for concern. Just concerns in the brain that need to be blown out.

One day of it, you, as you is on the way to you. I looked for what you wanted, but could not find it by skimming.

It is possible that you have caused me to think that you might be a little bit of the notion that I set forth about the book.
