Mr. EELCT advised that he has been employed one 2 cook for Mr. PETER CHEMPEL for the past neveral years and was as imployed of or CHEMPEL occupied the present house, 2668 flightand Avenue.

After being advised of the nature of the interview, he stated that he remembers EFIC CALT only variety. He remembers that he occupied Boom 14 for short two months churtly after they first moved into that house. He said that he serves breakfast to the boarders between 6 and 7:36 every norming and that this individual in Boom 14 came out of his room at approximately 7:15 or 7:20 after everyone else had finished breakfast and gone to work, had his breakfast and then went back to bed. KELLT advised that he remails "fussing" at this man several times for waiting so late to have his breakfast.

ELLY stated that he recalled something. peculiar about this man is that he paid for room and board each week he was there, except the last week, he only paid for a room and did not take any meals. He said that he recalls this individual stating that the reason he did not have reals was that he did not have any money.

KELLY views ' a compasitor drawing and stated that it rescribed 0.5, except that be believed GALT to be thinner in the face that this drawing indicated.

KELLT LE described as a Negro male, appreximately 50 years old.
