On $4 / 15 / 68$, an examination was made from the xerox copy fit the looseleal ledger book maintained by JIMMIE $D_{0}$ GARNER, 1.07 14th St., N.E., for the purpose of recording payments made by individuals renting rooms from him at 107 and 113 14th St., N.E., Atlanta, Georgia, at which time separate lists were made of individuals residing in both buildings during the pertinent period of March 24 to April 5, 1968, as well as those residing in each building during the non-pertinent period, which would be before or after the aforementioned time.

The above mentioned list revealed 21 potentials to interview due to the fact they resided in one of the buildings during the pertinent period. Six of these individuals were interviewed initially, along with other individuals who had moved into the building since 4/5/68, leaving 19 potentials to be interviewed. Identifiable information was available in GARNER's records regarding only six of these potentials. Leads were set out to interview these individuals who were:
