2 Panthers Killed in Duel With Police

CHICAGO, Dec. 4—Illinois Black Panther Chairman Fred Hampton and another Panther leader, were killed early today in a police raid on their gunfilled West Side apartment.

The pre-dawn gun battle at 2337 West Monroe St. left four other occupants of the apartment wounded. Two policemen were injured, one grazed in the leg by a bullet, the other cut on the head by flying glass.

The second Panther killed was Mark Clark, 22, of Peoria, described as a downstate leader of the party.

Within hours, the shootout became a matter of controversy.

Bobby Rush, local deputy minister of dissent for the Panthers, charged that the police "undertook a search-anddestroy mission this morning in their relentions plan to destroy the Black Panther Party."

But State's Attorney Edward V. Hanrahan, displaying nine shotguns, seven pistols, two carbines and several hundred rounds of ammunition confiscated from the Panther aparament, declared: "We whole-heartedly com-

"We whole heartedly commend the police officers for their brevery, their remarkable restraint and their discipline in the face of this vicious Black Panther attack and we expect every decent citizen of our community to do likewise."

The officers who staged the raid were Chicago police assigned to Hanrahan.

At 4:45 a.m., the 14-men police detail, armed with a submachinegun, shotgups and revolvers and carrying a search warrant, knocked on the door of the first-floor apartment.
