

Black Street Fights Forecast by Chisholm

Rep. Shirley Chisholm (D-N.Y.), an outspoken Negro member of Congress, said yesterday blacks from all segments of society are joining militants in demanding "their share of the so-called American dream."

Mrs. Chisholm, in an interview, said "Blacks are even ready to sacrifice their lives. They're through with tokenism, they're through with gradualism and they're through with see-how-far-you've-comeism. They want their share of the American dream now."

"... At one time we believed it was only the deprived or the black extremists that were engaged in these troubles," Mrs. Chisholm said. "But now, there's a cross section; upper class black, mid-

dle class blacks, phd'ers, people of lower economic level... In other words, we will find every strata of blacks moving out in this massive liberation struggle and it's definitely going to be fought more and more in the open streets."

She said blacks were frustrated by lack of educational opportunity, "narrow-minded, racist attitudes" among some congressmen, and a lag by the executive branch in implementing civil rights laws.
