

## Panther Plot on Officials Reported

WASHINGTON (AP) — A purported Black Panther blueprint for executing top Illinois city and state officials and destroying communications, power and transportation facilities was presented Thursday at a House internal security subcommittee hearing.

The eight-page, typed outline was one of several documents turned over to the subcommittee by Sgt. Ronald W. Bates, a special investigator of the Indianapolis Police Department, who said he had gotten them from a disillusioned former Black Panther member.

"He said these documents were for use if and when the Black Panther Party reaches the strength to conduct its revolution in the United States," Bates told the subcommittee.
