Some Negro leaders have questioned this column's re port that black militants, par ticularly the Black Panthers are trying to drive lawmen, firemen and other government agents out of the ghettos.

The facts are available in many big-city police and fire stations. Not only are officers summoned into the ghettos by repeated false alarms, but they risk attack from hostile residents.
