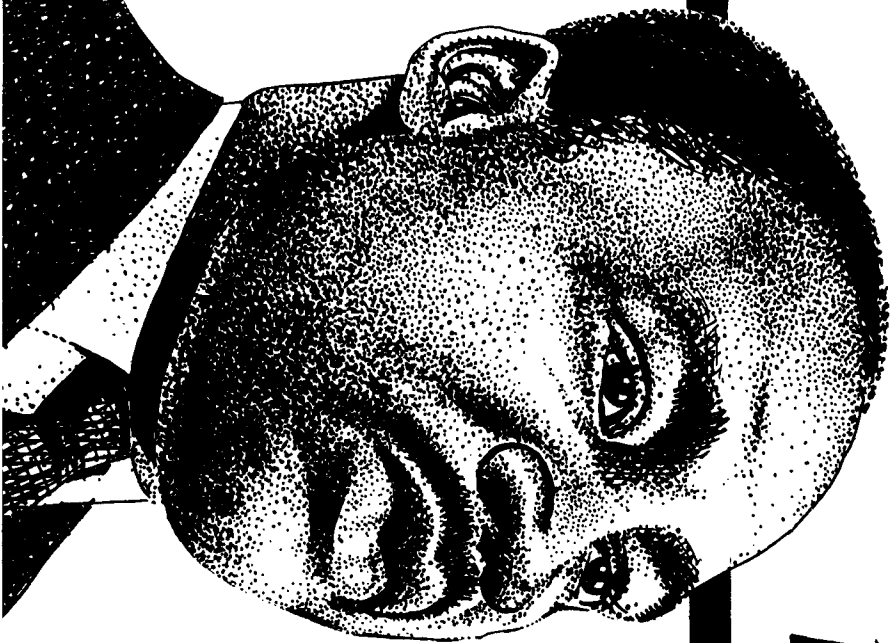


A Working Peoples' Observance of the Struggles and Goals of Rev. Martin Luther King Jr.
