Dear Art,

Thanks for your mailing 13 v. CNS 7/12 "Kennedy" story, 2 adds. Just what I've been looking for.

However, your stamp machine went crazy or something else was enclosed but didn't get here. With envelope, this weighed less than $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. The postage was 16¢.

Appreciate if you can send anything else as it is available. I have reason to believe that on the q/t. your police have started a re-investigation, that they are looking for or have found one Robert Clayton Quick (recently released MacNeil's Island, which should make locating easy through parole officer LA), that he places Blehr when she was unmarried (Warner) in Mexico 1963, and that she is alleged to have told LAPD otherwise.

Should this thing break, hit the horn to me. Meanwhile, I have something of some interest on which I am dealing with someone else near here. However, let me assure you that there can be no excuse for anything having happened to any evidence and that the most reasonable explanation is that it was arranged. It would appear to me to have been more likely through setting Charach or someone like him up than Blehr.

Charach had press conference here ^(DC) week ago, did not favorably impress those I know who were there (need not be reflection on him), seems to be well enough financed. No idea source or sources.

It is inevitable that something has to happen, esp. if the court clerk and DA start pushing each other. Houghton had key to locked evidence, not only clerk's office. Total four keys only as of my last knowledge, time of trial, approx.

Aside from what Blehr's moves may cause.

There could be error, but this copy says weapon used to kill tampered with. If so, this also is new.

Do you have a copy of Walker's order on the evidence? I'd like it if no trouble.
