

Bomb, Timer Found In J. F. Kennedy School

Cambridge, Mass.—(AP)—An incendiary bomb attached to a timed detonator was found yesterday in the kitchen of a building at the John F. Kennedy School of Government of Harvard University.

A state police explosives expert defused the device and removed it from the 2½-story building. The device was made of four plastic bags filled with gasoline and the detonating mechanism. It was found by an employe of the school who said she smelled a strong odor of gasoline.
