SUBJECT: Payment to QJWAN

1. QJWD was recruited in Brussels 1 November 1960 to undertake a secret mission to the Belgian Congo. Because the mission potentially involved great personal risk to him and he was obliged to separate himself from his business affiliations, it was agreed orally by this writer with QJWD that his compensation would be at the rate of \$1,000.00 per month, plus his expenses, for a period of no less than one month and no more than five months.
 2. Prior to departing for the Congo QJWD was obliged to travel to several European countries in order to make secret arrangements. The entire period of his employment from the beginning of his mission until his return from the Congo covered the months of November and December, 1960. For this period he has been paid completely in various sums by the _____ sessions and this writer who paid him \$100.00. Receipts made for all payrolls of salary to QJWD. There are, in addition, operational expenses for which he has been reimbursed by the _____ statistical which will forward complaint.
