Dear Mr. Belin:

The attached documents are in response to your letter of 23 May concerning research of DPD files related to Cuban operations." They are among documents already seen by Mr. Cargill in the Office of the Inspector General last week.

Please note that the cable traffic cited is that between members of the various Cuban action groups and their case officers. It is raw traffic (with emphasis on the raw) containing day-to-day thoughts of avid conspirators often exaggerated.

To help you in understanding the cables, we attach also a breakout sheet to describe the cryptonyms and codewords used. The breakout sheet is incomplete. The problem is that the traffic and the operations are so old we simply no longer have the breakouts for all of the codewords employed at that time.

Because of the sensitivity of the raw traffic and the breakout sheets, we would appreciate very much considering this package to be on loan to you and to be returned to us upon completion of the Commission's inquiry. We will of course make it a matter of the permanent record in the event of some future reason to reexamine documents of interest to the Commission.
