According to DRI a recent document from the National Archives lists the following occupants as living at 1326 N. Beckley at the time of the assassination:

BUDDY JOE PALMER
C. C. LEHMANN
ROY SAMUEL CLEGHORN
FLOYD DEGRAFFENREID or DeGRAFFENRED
HUGH SLOUGH
JACK CODY
GEORGE GIBBONEY
DONALD GREEN
JOHN CARTER
JAMES WATSON
HERBERT LEE

(It is noteworthy that O. H. LEE does not appear on documents nor have Dallas researchers been able to locate any of the above names at that address in 1963 or 1964 Directories. Apparently no effort was made by the FBI or other law enforcement personnel to interview any of OSWALD's co-roomers).

Present research does show a BOBBY PALMER, City policeman in 1963 at 4531 Columbia Street (already a key apartment area) and a JAMES WATSON, a City detective.

DR-1 states that during efforts to make contact with members of the NATIONAL STATES RIGHTS PARTY source was advised that the "true head" of the NSRP was a certain RETIRED ADMIRAL JOHN CROMMELIN, described as a man in his 70's, and resident of Wetumka, Alabama. CROMMELIN'S name has appeared, but not designated as head of NSRP, in THE THUNDERBOLT publication recently.

SUBJECT: Miscellaneous notes for future reference

Our Dallas researcher has pointed out that one JACK LANNE had loaned his mother's car to GUY BANISTER for use in the detective agency and was a twice-daily caller to BANISTER's office. However, the informant who pointed this out to the researcher stated that BANISTER wouldn't even notice LANNE. On the otherhand it is to be noted that on an interview February 29 with ORESTE PENA, PENA pointed to a card left at a barmaid's house when LANNE had been making inquiries concerning him (PENA) and also the day before had been to PENA's bar making inquiries. PENA does not know LANNE's name has come up before in this investigation.

Commission Document #826 refers to LEE HARVEY OSWALD as "HARVEY LEE OSWALD". This is a slip similar to that made in Dallas by H. L. HUNT in conversation with me as well as one or two other significant misquotes of the OSWALD name. Note that Document 826 deals with the fact that the name list and photograph of LEE HARVEY OSWALD supposedly discovered on his person at the time he was arrested in New Orleans for distribution of pro-Castro literature had been misplaced and were not rediscovered until November 23 after the assassination of President Kennedy when the Secret Service called on Lt. MARTELLO. Commission Document #827 concerns a copy of that list as it was turned over to Secret Service agent ADRIAN VIAL, this spelling is the same as that of JACK RUBY's Dallas lawyer friend, ROBERT G. VIAL of the Mercantile Security Building, a partner of the firm of Aiken, Hamilton, Graham, Koch & Tubbs.
