JERRY COHEN, LA TIMES, Phone 625-0471, called to advise that GARRISSON (New Orleans) told LAUREN HALL to tell COHEN that if he checked closely on the Wallace Headquarters at Lankershim Blvd., No. Hollywood, they would learn something significant to the Gault Case. Garrison alleged that BRADLEY and GAULD had been habitués of the Wallace Hq. on Lankershim.

COHEN said in checking he did learn that the Wallace Hq. on Lankershim is closed. He checked at Wallace H. in Bell Gardens and learned that Bradley was a Wallace fan and did attend Wallace rallies. He was unable to establish any association or acquaintance between Bradley and Gault but thought is significant that Gault was known at Wallace HQ in No. Hollywood and that Bradley was known at Wallace HQ in Bell Gardens.
