

Beall Subpoenaed By County Court

BALTIMORE (AP) — George Beall, the U.S. Attorney for Maryland preparing for the federal prosecution of Arthur Bremer, was subpoenaed Monday to testify before a county court in connection with the May 15 shooting of Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace.

Beall, saying he would not appear at Wednesday's hearing in the Prince Georges County Circuit Court, filed a motion to quash the subpoena issued by Benjamin Lipsitz, Bremer's defense attorney.

The county hearing is being held on motions filed by Lipsitz, who claims that state and federal authorities are engaged in a "race to the courtroom" to be the first to try the 21-year-old former Milwaukee busboy charged with the Wallace shooting.

Lipsitz said he wanted Beall to bring records and tabulations showing the dispositions of similar cases where a defendant was charged in both state and federal jurisdictions.
