

Bremer Turned Over To State For Trial

BALTIMORE (AP) — The accused assailant of Gov. George C. Wallace has been turned over to Prince Georges County authorities and is no longer under federal guard, officials said Thursday.

Both George Beall, U.S. attorney for Maryland, and Thomas H. Farrow, special agent in charge of the Baltimore office of the FBI, said the actual change in custody of Arthur H. Bremer, the suspect, occurred Tuesday at Clifton T. Perkins State Hospital in Jessup, Md.

Bremer, 21, was ordered to Perkins by Prince Georges County Circuit Court Judge Ralph W. Powers to undergo a series of psychiatric tests.

Prince Georges County officials confirmed the turnover but said a court order forbidding authorities from talking about the case prevented them

from saying where the suspect was being held and which agency is guarding him.
