Bremer Taken 7-4-72 For Mental Test

BALTIMORE, July 3 (UPI)

—Arthur H. Bremer, accused of shooting Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace, was moved from the Baltimore County jail today to a state hospital for mental examination.

FBI agents took Bremer, 21, from the jail before dawn to the Clifton T. Perkins State Hospital at Jessup, about 20 miles south of Baltimore.

The mental testing of the former Milwaukee busboy was ordered by Judge Ralph W. Powers of Prince George's County Circuit Court after Bremer changed his plea from innocent to innocent by reason of insanity.
