## Wallace Is Improving; Moved From Care Ward

Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace is improving and was moved out of the intensive care unit in Holy Cross Hospital in Silver Spring yesterday, according to campaign aide Elvin Stanton.

Meanwhile, in Houston, Cornelia Wallace said in a news conference that she was "still hopeful" her husband would attend the Democratic Convention in Miami in mid-July—a statement of hope some-

what less firm than earlier assertions by campaign aides that the governor would certainly attend the convention. Mrs. Wallace was attending the National Governors' Conference in Houston.

Mrs. Wallace also said that her husband is suffering greatly from a stomach infection caused by a bullet that passed through his stomach before lodging in his spine. Wallace was shot May 15 at a political rally in Laurel.

It was not clear yesterday whether the governor would remain in Holy Cross for an expected operation to remove the bullet from his spine, or would be taken somewhere else.
