

Federal Charges Against Bremer Are Dropped

The U.S. District Court in Baltimore has dismissed federal charges against Arthur H. Bremer, convicted in the attempted assassination of Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace, at the request of the Justice Department.

Bremer, convicted on state charges stemming from the shooting of Wallace in Laurel during the

1972 presidential campaign, is serving a 53-year sentence in the Maryland Penitentiary.

Bremer was indicted by a federal grand jury on four counts, including injuring a candidate for a presidential nomination, assaulting a special agent of the Secret Service and firearms violations.
