

**Prisoner Punished
After Scuffling**

MOBILE, Oct. 13 (AP) — A convict in the Alabama State Prison was punished for scuffling with other prisoners and Pentecostal church authorities. The prison authorities announced that the convict, whose name was not disclosed, was sentenced to 30 days in the prison for the incident. The convict was caught when another inmate made a comment about his race and religion. The convict will lose movie privileges and yard privileges for 30 days starting Monday. There was no evidence of a fight. Bremer's attorney, Bob Grams, said the prison officer for the corrections system was board found guilty to be the aggressor in the scuffle.
