

Bremer Irked By Homosexual

BALTIMORE, Oct. 10 (AP)—Arthur Herman Bremer, serving a 30-year sentence for last May's shooting of Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace and three other persons, has accused another inmate of making homosexual advances and threats, a Maryland prison official said today.

Bob Grams, a spokesman for the state corrections department, said a formal hearing into the accusation is scheduled to be held Wednesday at the Maryland Penitentiary.

"Bremer accused another inmate of making homosexual advances and stating if Bremer did not receive the advances, he would kill him," Gram said.
