

### ***Small Fire Set In Jail Protest***

Eight inmates at the Prince George's County jail, protesting because they said they were served hot dogs containing pork, started a small fire in their cellblock yesterday, Sheriff Don E. Ansell reported.

Ansell said the disturbance started about 2 p.m. and the fire was put out in about 3 minutes.

The jail is about 100 yards east of the County Courthouse, where Arthur Bremer was being tried on charges of shooting Alabama Gov. George C. Wallace and three other persons. Ansell said the hot dogs were all beef and were also served to the Bremer jury and witnesses. He said he didn't know if the complaining inmates were Black Muslims, but said they refused to eat pork.
