A review of PD-302's reflects that ~~JESSE R. CORE, III~~ was interviewed by SA JAMES ROYCE ~~PHI~~, 11/29/63, concerning handbills handed out in front of the International Trade Mart, 8/16/63. CORE stated he observed ~~his~~ activity for some 20 to 25 minutes and saw ~~two~~ people handing out handbills.

CORE should be recontacted with ~~photos~~ of this activity to determine if the two persons ~~observed~~ by him were OSWALD and CHARLES HALL STEELE and whether or not he observed a third person handing out handbills. It is noted that STEELE and OSWALD are the only ~~ones~~ who can be definitely determined from photos as handing out the handbills but STEELE has stated when he met OSWALD in front of the International Trade Mart Building he ~~was~~ accompanied by another individual described as having olive complexion, dark hair and approximately 6 feet tall, who ~~apparently~~ was handing out some handbills.
