3 money to Carlos, was that the time that you met Lee Oswald?

4 A. I don't know if I turned in the money or  
5 not. No, I don't think I turned in money, but I couldn't  
6 be sure. I remember I went there, and that is the time the  
7 last guy, Vance Blalock, came along with me. It was his  
8 first time and everything. And we went in there -- I might  
9 have turned it in, I am not too sure. Maybe I did, maybe I

11 anyway talking to him and that is when I met him.

12 Q. That is when you met Oswald?

13 A. Yes. You want me to tell all that?

18 what the conversation was, who was there.

19 A. Well, we were -- Vance and me went in there,  
20 Vance and I, we went into there, I introduced Vance to Carlos,  
21 and Carlos started talking to him about, you know, freedom  
22 and all that, democracy and everything. Then later on while  
23 we were talking, Lee Oswald came in, you know, while we were  
24 talking, and he came in a little while later. He was by  
25 himself and he seemed a little nervous. I remember he was

Philip and A. Tenth. ... before we get into

the conversation Q. Tenth grade. Do you know Carlos Bringuiert?

A. I have met him once.

Q. How did it happen that you met him?

A. I went downtown with my friend, Philip or Geraci. We went to a store to return funds that Philip had collected for the organization this man had had, and while I was there I met Carlos. That is how I met him.

Q. Did you have anything to do with these funds that were collected by your friend Geraci?

A. No, sir, I didn't. ... and Philip

introduced me Q. That was entirely his operation?

A. Yes. ... and I told him I was curious

about it Q. Do you remember where you went that day with Philip?

A. Yes, sir, we went to Decatur Street, I don't believe it is. I am not sure. The store is the Casa Rosa.

11 had with Bringuier when you went into the store.

12 A. Oh, we entered the store and Philip  
13 introduced me to Carlos, and I told him -- I saw the funds  
14 Philip had collected for him, and I told him I was curious  
15 about what it was for, and then he explained how the  
16 organization worked for me and told me he received the funds  
17 from people in New Orleans and sent it to Florida, and that  
18 was his total business, and he explained that Communism was  
19 where the kids are supposed to tell everything on their  
20 parents, to obey the State and not their parents.

21 Q. Present at this conversation were just you  
22 and Philip and Carlos? Is that right?

23 A. No, there was another man -- must have  
24 worked at the store. He was present.
