# CUBA TO BLAME, BRINGSTER SAYS

## Hijacking of Plane Is Called Criminal

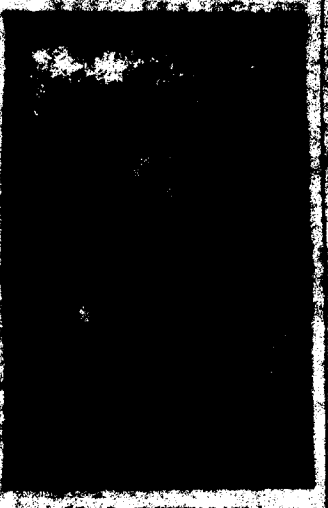
The New South Division of the Cuban Police Directorate has issued a statement calling to the attention of the American public the recently kidnaping of a man in the air and the dangerous hijacking of a National Air Lines plane in which the lives of 20 passengers were endangered.

Said the statement, signed by Carlos Bringster, "This new act of piracy shows once again the criminal activities of Dictator Castro's agents not only in Cuba, but right here in the United States.

"The officer who received the hijackers in Havana, Bringster, is a well-known officer to the attention of the chief of the Department of Internal Security in Red Cuba, and is also the director of some of the Castro infiltration groups in the United States. At the time he was the chief of Fidel Castro's bodyguards.

"The fact that the Cuban government know beforehand of the arrival shows the complicity of the Castro government in this criminal act, that has paralleled with the tactics of the Gestapo under Nazi Germany," Bringster said.
