Post of 1911 Heavy Guard Posted Over H. Rap Brown

H. Rap Brown, captured Saturday after a shoot out with police, was reported in fair condition yesterday at New York's Roosevelt Hospital where he remained under guard by about a dozen policemen.

Meanwhile, officials in New York and an FBI spokesman here reported no new developments in the case, saying they had no information on where Brown had been during the 17 months he was a fugitive from the law.

Brown, according to a detective who guarded him during the day, continued to maintain that he was Roy Williams of Mississippi. The detective reported, however, that Brown was visited by his brother, Eddie, and they carried on a conversation in whispers.

Police said an attempt to fingerprint Brown again Sunday was unsuccessful because of the prisoner's condition. They said they needed the fingerprints for his arraignment.

Police said Sunday they had identified Brown from fingerprints after one of three mencaptured along with him identified Brown to authorities.

Brown, 28, was shot in the abdomen early Saturday morning following the holdup of an Upper West Side tavern. Police said Brown was connered on the roof on a nearly building and shot twice when he pointed a gun at an officer.
