ON KING:

ON THREE THIRTY, SIXTY-FIVE, [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] DIXIE KLANS, WAS INTERVIEWED BY SAS [REDACTED]
AND [REDACTED] AT CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE. AT THAT TIME
BROWN STATED HE WAS SURPRISED KING HAD NOT BEEN KILLED IN
ALABAMA TO DATE. HE SAID IF KING EVER CAME TO THE CHATTANOOGA
AREA AND DID THE SAME THINGS HE WAS DOING IN ALABAMA, SOMEONE
WOULD KILL HIM. HE DID NOT COMMENT AS TO WHO WOULD KILL KING.
ALTHOUGH SUBJECT RAY HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS THE ASSAILANT, YOU
SHOULD CONDUCT INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE IF BROWN MIGHT BE
IMPLICATED AS A CONSPIRATOR.
