Hurriedly, your letter 8/51 not based on fact. There are two dinscontinuous head movements, second 313. Head motion instantaneous, not delayed. Com ission printed 314, 315 reversed. Bullet visible still going 313, about 2 fast from head. If you saw movie, this would be sickeningly clear. I spotted it first showing, even if at fast motion rather than normal. The problem is that what soons to be going forward from JFK head as bullet may not be but may be from explosion inside head. There is no doubt the nead im ediately snaps backward, then in the very next frame comes back, then he goes, unmistaleably to his left. There is no visible laft strike nor any motion suggestive of it. The opposite. The damage to the brain was, I think more extensive than you project.

The forward notion comes earlier, I do not know the exect frame and cannot be sure because I've discovered another crockedness: no frame 284. Instead, 283 twice.

A bullet hits hard. The body goes as the bullet knocks it. When the reaction has time, the body snaps back.

I now have an FMI report that says this also of the Nix film at that frame, that the immidiate and initial reaction is not forward, not to the right, but to the laft.

I think you're off of this one.
