Four have been arraigned and have been held in bonds of \$25,000 and \$50,000 for examination, the dates for which have not been fixed. Miss Grace Buchanan-Dineen,

attractive 34-year-old cosmopolite and defendant who was a Govern-ment witness before the Federal grand jury, has not yet been ar-räigned on the indictment.
