U.S. Agents Checked Kremlin for "Bugs"

MOSCOW, May 24 (AP) —U.S. security agents made their usual careful search for electronic eavesdropping devices before President Nixon moved into his temporary headquarters in the Kremlin, informed sources confirmed today.

Wherever the President goes, be it Chicago or Moscow, one of the items on the security checklist is an inspection with sophisticated devices to make certain his private conversations are kept private.

The check in Moscow was carried out by agents in the advance contingent which arrived weeks before Nixon.
