He recently said he was serious to right his 96.

He recently said he was anxious to visit his 96-year-old father, who is in an Australian nursing home, but feared that he might not be allowed to leave Australia if he returned.

The Australian Cabinet recently reviewed the newsman's case, and Immigration Minister Billy Snedden said today Burchett would not be given a passport "or any other means of facilitating travel."
