SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY

Re previous memo 11-23-63 of SA UNGERMANN.

On November 23, 1963, at 11:50 a.m., SA ROBERT HAINES telephonically advised from the Lambert Airport, St. Louis, that he had obtained the ammunition requested by the FBI Lab. HAINES stated that the fastest and quickest flight leaving St. Louis for Washington National Airport, Washington, D.C. would be in Eastern Air Line Flight 406, scheduled to leave at 2:30 p.m. and scheduled to arrive at Washington National Airport at 7:01 p.m., Eastern Standard Time. HAINES further advised he would be waiting at the airport to personally place the ammunition requested into the hands of Captain JAMES KEYSER. He also stated enclosed with the ammunition would be a copy of five orders of such ammunition manufactured by the Western Arms Division of Owens Mattheson Chemical Corporation, which reflects that five orders were placed for this ammunition in 1954 by the U.S. Marine Corps.

On November 23, 1963, at 11:58 p.m., the writer placed a telephone call to the FBI Lab, Washington, D.C., advising of the above information. Special Agent WARREN G. JOHNSON was in receipt of this information.
