A SQUARE is a revolutionary, and
proud of it. To SQUARES, Revolution is
a political condition, like peace or war.
Revolution can lead to the most freedom
with the least human cost, if ethically
managed. Revolution simply means
radical change through propaganda and
agitation—words and deeds. Therefore,
SQUARES are for a persistent
revolutionary condition—i.e., liberty
under law—in America and throughout
the world.

SQUARES remember that this nation
was born in revolution, that the word
itself derived from a description of the
orbiting of heavenly bodies, and that its
sister term "radical" means "root," not
renegade.
Revolutionaries, read on.

SQUARE PHILOSOPHY

SQUARES are idealists, not
materialists. They believe the mind
matters most. Hence, SQUARES believe
that the enemy is not a class, nor an
organization, nor institution, nor money,
nor any material things. To SQUARES,
the enemy is the Tendency Toward
Tyranny (TTT) which is in us all,
balanced by a Longing For Liberty
(LFL). In certain citizens, Tyranny like
the upper hand, and ideologies like
Nazism and Communism and "The
Death of Kings" are spread to

America's greatest difficulty is that we
have millions of military men and
diplomats, but nearly no revolutionaries

dictatorship. That's why liberty is losing
at home and abroad. We're not even in
the game, because we have no trained

CONFLICT MANAGERS ARE ETHICAL REVOLUTIONARIES

SQUARES fight fair, but ferociously, because they know that the cause of poverty and war is the Tendency Toward Tyranny in all of us, and that a new profession—Conflict Managers supported by Conflict Patrons—is needed to deal with TTT on a day-to-day basis. To SQUARES, men make systems, not vice versa, and merely changing the system solves nothing, unless you treat the underlying problems—human nature—professionally and daily. Thus, both Communist and Capitalist societies need Conflict Managers, to liberate one and to keep the other free, continually supported by the SQUARE Movement of Citizens Students... Servicemen.

My principal aim has always been to build a revolutionary mass movement, led by professional Conflict Managers, to guide the nation and world away from Tyranny and toward Liberty. That is, in a diametrically different direction from the New Left—Old Right. Polarization. So that the American people will have a real choice when the climax comes.

IS REVOLUTION THE SOLUTION?

WHAT IS REVOLUTION?

Revolution is the radical change of the existing order, primarily by means of propaganda and agitation among the citizenry. There are thousands of degrees within revolutionary reality—from the mildest written and spoken rhetoric, to peaceful protest, to assassinations, riots, strikes, sabotage, etc. In other words, revolution is a profound change in the status quo by words and acts of private people (rather than officials). The change can be good as well as bad.

Revolutions begin from secure base areas near the scene of conflict. For example, pro-Castroites in Mexico and later Miami supported the Cuban Revolution, first with words then with actions, guns, money, etc. Once Cuba was captured, turndown was fair play. Propaganda and agitation were launched first against Latin America, where instructions exploded; then against the U.S. where Oswald was incited to kill Kennedy and thereby triggered a massive result which is still going on.

WHY DID IT HAPPEN HERE?

The revolution exploded so dramatically in the U.S. with such devastating effect, for several reasons. First, because most Americans believed "it can't happen here." Insulated behind a shield of stainless steel and plastic we

brought to nearly the boiling point without warning. Just social grievances at home and abroad were continually shogged under a carpet of currency and left there to smolder. The outraged cries of the oppressed were ruthlessly censored by a government/communications axis of wise men at the top who cooperated to conceal reality from the people. They painted Eisenhower as the Perfect Patriarch and Kennedy as the Prodigious Son. They pretended to us (and themselves) that we could solve revolutionary problems with the same simple diplomatic/military dichotomy

which attracts the other activists, the crowds, and the publicity. It is no accident that the SQUARE Movement, even with minimal mobilization, has done so much and attracted so much publicity in the process.

Reporters write about us, and people read about us, because people are interested in the new, the unexpected, the different. Doctrinaire "Left" and "Right" sparring is an unmitigated bore, and has solved nothing in a century. But when a Beale gets a crew cut, or a SQUARE supports revolution, that's news, baby! The typical SQUARE comes

Words are weapons.

To a professional, who uses them every day, this is not some silly figure of speech—as America is beginning to learn. Words can kill people.

I met Oswald before he killed President Kennedy and tried to warn people about him, because Communist propaganda had mangled his mind.

Three years before race riots blitzed two dozen American cities, Castro launched an invisible invasion to incite them.

Until Americans grasp the simple fact that words can kill—whether shouted openly in frenzy, whispered secretly in conspiracy, or printed blandly in newspapers—then we will be tragically vulnerable.

It is disturbing to read, see and hear Communist propaganda surfacing in our own press. And it is chilling to know that, of one hundred people reading it in the same newspaper, one may comprehend its true meaning slightly, eight will doubt it partially, but care little; 90 will believe, but won't act; and one will decide to kill because of it.

While we rush around searching for some bastard bullet at Pavlovian command, and look for the legend "Made in Cuba by Castro" on the bottom of Molotov Cocktails, Communists are firing mental missiles into the midst of America, through our own mass media, and mails.

And Americans are dying wherever they strike. That, and not plots, is the point of this epoch.

AGITATION: DEFINITION

AGITATION is the planned motivation and organization of people by any and all means, to achieve social, military, political or economic effects.
