WRC-TV News also filmed and aired him. The Commentary referred to his groups as "all 20 of them". It also showed them marching, rather ridiculously, and shouting "Peace but No Surrender" or "Peace WithoutnSurrender". The only Mobe opposition other than Butler it showed was Rev Carl McIntyre, who appeared at Arlington with a wreath to place at the tomb of the unknown soldier. He was allowed to enter cemetery but was not allowed to place wreath by guard at the tomb. He took loud offense, claiming that having been permitted to enter the cemetery he had been "cleared". Finally, the guard had to ask him to show respect for ~~the~~ grave he was pretending to honor. He too, may have had as many as 20 followers. In both cases the camera showed their number, and it was quite small. Although other cameras didn't pick it up, here the "Square" flag Butler uses was prominent, and he was shown carrying no American flag. The camera was too far away for me to be certain, but when he read a prayer at the Lincoln memorial, it seemed to be resting on a Square emblem, a stiff one (The flag was also stiff, as though printed on cardboard).
