Dear Mr. Casey,

Your letter of 1/26 reached me as I am about to leave on a trip that will take several weeks.

From your letter I take it you have none of my books. I have published four, and the fifth of a projected series of seven is ready for publication as soon as I can risk the additional debt. You seem to want all works in this field, therefore, to save you time and cost I am sending you all of them. We maintain a list of those who want automatic shipment and, if you desire, we can mail you the others as they appear. Please let us know.

The total cost of these books is \$16.50 plus postage. If there is any you do not want, you may, of course, return it.

There is quite a list of "Kennedy books". I could not provide it for I am unfamiliar with most of them. However, I am familiar with the literature on the assassination. If this is what interest you, if you will provide me with a list of those you have I'll be glad to tell you of any others on my return. Two that you may not now about are by Penn Jones, Jr., whose total address is Midlothian, Texas 76065. They are "Forgive My Grief" and "Forgive My Grief II". They are \$2.95 each. However, he has a special price where both are purchased together. I think if you send him four dollars he will send you both.

Of course, I am also familiar with the major works on Kennedy as distinguished from those on the assassination. If this is your interest, I would be pleased to scan your list and let you know if there are any important ones I can think of that you do not have. Our local bookstore is operated by a friend of mine and I think, should you so desire, he would undertake to supply what you might want.
