Dear Mr. Copeland,

Many thanks for your very fine letter, which I do appreciate very much

The first book, WHITEWASH: THE REPORT ON THE WARREN REPORT, which you do not mention, is available in the same format from us and at the same price, or in a 95¢ Dell reprint.

It now looks as though WHITEWASH III will be about a month late. I am squeezing in what little additional time I can find in the archive and it has been fruitful. This, with the other interruptions, have me behind schedule. We'll mail it as soon as it is ready.

I wish there were lawyers close to Washington who had the interest and dedication to go farther with some of the things I've laid a basis for, especially on suppression. I have exhausted my administrative remedies and would like to file suit on the illegality of the action that suppresses so much, like the spectrographic analyses of the bullet and fragments, the autopsy pictures and X-rays and, I think more important, the autopsy notes, which do exist, in spite of everything all the others writing in the field say, and other such items I believe cannot properly be suppressed. We are still too far in debt to undertake the additional debt of hiring a lawyer, if I could find one who would pursue it diligently. And, of course, decent lawyers are busy men.

I'd particularly like to find a lawyer who would not like to use this as a means of selling books, for were that my intention I'd have done something on my own by now.

Again, thank you very much for taking the time to write such a nice letter.
