Dear Dr. Seaborg:

By Executive Order No. 11130, dated November 29, 1963, President Johnson appointed a Commission to investigate and report on the facts relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. I am serving as Chairman of the Commission and the Commission has requested Mr. J. Lee Rankin to serve as General Counsel.

At the outset of our work, the Commission desires to obtain from your agency all information relating to Lee Harvey Oswald, recently of Dallas, Texas, and Jack E. Ruby, a one-time resident of Chicago, Illinois and currently a Dallas resident, as well as any other information which you believe may be relevant to our investigation. It would be appreciated by the Commission if you would prepare two copies of any such materials in your files and send them to Mr. Rankin, Room 401, Veterans of Foreign Wars Building, 200 Maryland Avenue, N.E., Washington, D. C. 20002. It would also facilitate the work of the Commission if you will make the necessary arrangements to ensure that any and all pertinent information developed in the future by your agency, which relates to these principals or the assassination, is directed as soon as possible to Mr. Rankin.
