Dear George,

Just a note of thanks, so don't take time to answer.

Martin does remember being here a decade or so ago. He says he's often wondered what I've done since then and is going to find out soon. He plans to come soon.

He is interested in the story I suggested and in seeing what I have.

I have no count on the total but the FBI alone says I've gotten about a third of a million pages from it. I guess that aside from my own work and investigations I now have something like a half million pages of once-secret <sup>official</sup> records.

There is an index to most of the JFK stuff, so that much is fairly readily accessible, for CBS and anybody else.

When Martin leaves he and CBS should have some notion of the scope and content.

And he and thus CBS will also know where it will be available when it is deposited in the university archive I've arranged for.

A fairly complete file of newspaper clippings with much radio stuff ~~XXXX~~ is already there.

I also have an extensive King file. My next writing will be based on it.
