Although it is not 'nown wheth r, in fact, James Earl Ray dictated the statement or if it was wanufactured by his brother Jerry Tar, in view of its non-substantiated content, it is not falt that we should further pursue it at this time. A copy of the statement is being furnished to the Civil Rights Division for its information with advice that no inquiries are being conducted on the contents of this statement unless specifically requested. We will remain alert to any additional statements by Ray or any other individuals relating to this case and thoroughly run out any leads of partinence?

DITAILS:

JAMES FARL MAY'S STATEMENT:

Eay claims that in the Spring of 1968, he was working with Agents of the Federal Government, including "Laoul" and was teld that he, key, was assisting in supplying arms to Cuban refugees to overthrow Castro and the Communists in Cuba. He states that he was led to believe that he was in Memphis in April (1968) for the same purpose when, in fact, he was actually used as a "fall guy" to cover up the Willing of King by Federal Agents. He points out that the facility with which he crossed the help of Federal Sgents who with the Ecvican Police afforded

Bay states that William Bradford Huie admits that the FBI and Merican Police knew all of Ray's movements in Mexico and he did not know of King being in Memphis until after the shooting. He states that he realizes that the Federal Agents had no interest in overthrowing Castro and only used him to cover up the killing of Hing. He continues that two Federal Agencies are guilty and he is innocent and that he hopes that some higher Government official will expose the plot so that he will be freed from prisen. Bay states that he does not know what motives the Federal Agents had for killing King and suggests that former Attorney - General Eamsey Clark be asked as he may 'snow.

Ray, in closing, stated he wanted to pass along a message to Percy Foreman, Arthur Hanes (two of Ray's former Attorneys) and William Bradford Huie (author who wrote articles ou Ray) that they got their wish but they along with Ramsey Clar's would be ruined before this matter is closed. He indicates he hopes to talk to CBS in person in the near future if Tennessee State and Federal authorities don't block it.

MALYSIS:

Eacul is the individual who, according to William Bradford Muie's articles in "Look" magazine which were based on Rry's statements to Muie, was endeavoring to make some type of deal concerning a "joint activity" for which kaoul would pay Ray 312,000. The specific nature of the "joint activity" was not fully described or identified but hay was to transport packages between the United States and Canada. The possibility exists that the packages could contain contraband

Extensive investigation has been conducted in an effort to identify Raoul to no avail. No information has been developed indicating Eag was connected with any United States Federal Agency or the Merican Folice or involved in any way with antifastro activities. The procedures for passage between the United States and Canada and Merico, respectively are not difficult nor do they require any particular Governmental sanction. There is no statement in the William Bradford Huie articles on Pay wherein Huie alleges that the FEI and Mexican Police knew all of Kay's movements in Merico. During the course of our extensive abouts from the time of his escape from prison in April, 1967, until his apprehension in Londan in June, 1937, and his subsequent incarceration in the Tennessee State Prison is Fashville, Tennessee.
