## Sir:

The virtuoso displays of ignorance of basic and readily accessible fact by your two grown men, Alexander Bickel and Walter Lister (NR 8/19/67), each of whom thinks he has bought and owns the only true religion by the loudness of his prayer that the Emperor indeed wears clothes, is made possible by their stupefying self-satisfaction and blinding bias, as they were made acceptable to their opposing factions of the same Eastern intellectual clan by the abdications of both factions and expressable by the captive medium each used.
